Mock Examinations

The mock examinations will run as closely as possible to the official Junior Cycle examination timetable. The full timetable is included below.

All State Examination rules will apply, including the requirement to wear full school uniform each day. Any disruption during exams may result in removal from the examination centre and cancellation of that exam. A detailed breakdown of procedures will be issued closer to the time.

Students are only required to attend school for examinations in subjects they are studying.

To support students in their preparation, study skills seminars have been delivered to all students, and parents were invited to attend a recent study morning. Homework Club is also available every Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, providing a supervised space for students to study in preparation for the exams.

Senior Cycle Information Night

On Tuesday, February 24th, we will host an information evening for 3rd year parents to discuss senior cycle options, including Transition Year, LCA, and the Leaving Certificate.
